

# SUBSUB

User Manual & Safety Guidelines — Full-Face Surface Snorkelling Mask

Last updated: 23 June 2026

**Important:** SUBSUB is a full-face surface snorkelling mask with dry-top valves. It is **NOT** a diving

or scuba device and does not supply air — any time you are below the surface you are holding your

breath. Use it for surface snorkelling and **short breath-hold dives only**; never for deep diving,

free-diving or prolonged underwater use.

## 1. What's in the box

---

- 1 × SUBSUB full-face snorkelling mask (Black or White)
- 2 × dry-top snorkel tubes (left & right)
- 1 × adjustable head strap
- 1 × action-camera mount (camera not included)

## 2. How it works

---

- The full-face design lets you breathe naturally through your nose and mouth while you float face-down and look at the water below.
- The dual **dry-top valves seal automatically** the moment you dip below the waterline, so you can duck-dive for a closer look without water flooding the tubes or mask — and they reopen the instant you surface.
- Separated breathing channels help reduce fogging and CO<sub>2</sub> build-up.
- The panoramic lens gives a wide, clear field of view.

## 3. Fitting your mask

---

- Choose the correct size for a comfortable, leak-free seal (see the size guide on the product page).

- Pull your hair away from your face and position the mask over your nose and mouth.
- Tighten the head strap evenly — snug, never painful.
- Before entering the water, test the seal: breathe in gently; the mask should hold lightly to your face.

#### 4. In the water

---

- Use SUBSUB for relaxed snorkelling at the surface and short breath-hold dives below it.
- Dives must be **brief breath-hold dips only** — surface regularly to breathe. The mask does not supply air.
- Do **not** use SUBSUB for deep diving, free-diving or staying underwater.
- If water enters, lift your head, keep calm and clear the snorkel, or remove the mask.
- Exit the water immediately if you feel dizzy, short of breath, cold or tired.

#### 5. Safety guidelines

---

- Never snorkel alone — always use the buddy system.
- Stay well within your swimming ability and close to shore or a boat.
- Check local conditions before each session: currents, tides, weather and boat traffic.
- Do not use the mask under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or if unwell.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- SUBSUB is intended for confident swimmers, for recreational surface snorkelling and brief breath-hold dives only.

#### 6. Care & storage

---

- After each use, rinse the mask and snorkels with clean fresh water.
- Shake off excess water and let the mask air-dry away from direct sunlight.
- Do not use solvents or abrasive cleaners on the lens.
- Store in a cool, dry place, out of prolonged sun exposure.

#### 7. Warranty & support

---

- SUBSUB equipment is covered by a 12-month warranty.
